Secretary's Report

Welcome to another Cavalier year. We were very disappointed in the poor attendance at this year's Annual General Meeting and the August Special General Meeting. Fortunately, we did have a quorum and were therefore able to continue with the business of the night. As you can see from the committee list, again, we have a very small committee. As such, we can only commit to running the Open Show and Championship Shows and the Member's Competition associated with the Dog's Day out. We see the latter as an important platform for promotion of the breed and therefore an important inclusion in the Cavalier Calendar. It is hoped that we will again hold a Restricted to Height Agility trial.

It is pleasing that the members present at the meeting voted to return to the two show format for our Championship Shows. It was becoming apparent, with the proposed reconfiguring of the Dogs Victoria show calendar, that we could lose our two days. Dogs Vic have now given approval for us to hold two shows into the future. The members present also voted to allow committee the discretion to make changes to the show format based on circumstances and the best interests of the club. A great move in my view. The members present also voted to rationalize the Property classes at future shows with just six classes - the four colour classes, Victorian Owner Bred and Best Interstate exhibit.

Unfortunately, we only received one nomination for our 2016 judge, Ted Rogerson who notified me that he has been contracted elsewhere. Nominations were taken from the floor on the night. Mary Cunningham was nominated and elected to judge in 2016. Mary has not awarded CC's in the UK yet, so would not be approved by the ANKC to judge in Australia. We have secured Virginia Barwell (Charlottetown) for 2015 and Katie Sloan (Turretbank) and Gillian Greenall (Charlesworth) for our 2016 shows.

Sadly, not only are we dealing with a distinct lack of interest from members in important matters pertaining to the running of the club, but there are many secretive conversations criticizing your hard working committee. Obviously, we must be doing a good job. If not, why has nobody nominated for committee in recent years. Time to support your committee and cease the behind the scenes criticism and back stabbing.

In this newsletter, you will find critiques for the Monday show, the schedules for the December Comp and the Open show along with minutes and reports from the AGM and August SGM.

We have again decided to go with Show Manager for entries, this year with full service for all 2015 shows. We were very pleased with the service they provided for the Champ shows this year.



BREEDER'S PAGE ON WEBSITE

As voted on at the April Special General meeting and due to the poor uptake of the Puppy Referral Service by members, puppy referrals have been discontinued. Aidan and I rushed him off to the vet, and from there to Dr Robin Stanley's animal eye clinic as an emergency patient.

The staff at Animal Eye Care were nothing short of wonderful, but sadly, Soldier was diagnosed with glaucoma. The following afternoon, after I had experienced every emotion you could possibly imagine, Soldier's left eye was removed by one of the skilful surgeons at Craigieburn Animal Hospital.

If I had any doubts about how Soldier's life would be as a pirate puppy, they were soon put to rest! Within two hours of us bringing him home, Soldier had slept off the methadone, and was busily balancing on the back of the couch, clearing our 45cm high dog "barrier" with room to spare, and executing flying leaps out of the roof flap of his soft crate. He made it absolutely clear in his own special way that he was going to be just fine.

Almost two months to the day he injured his eye, Soldier re-entered the Rally ring for the first time as a pirate puppy. I was keen to show off what the little tyke could do. And boy, did he show the world what he could do!

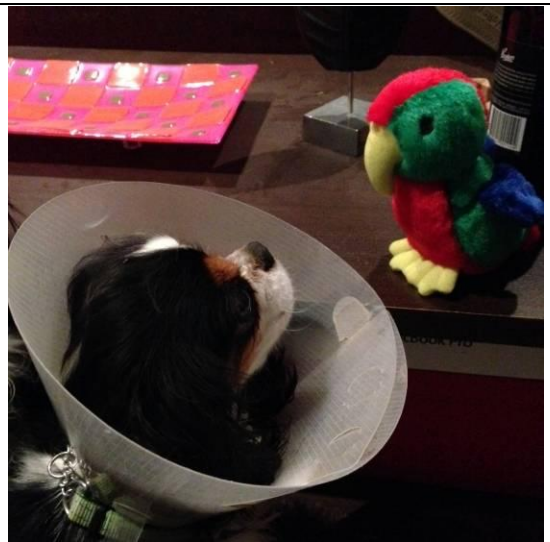

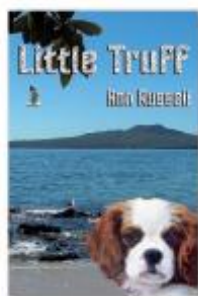
